- Last but not least: nurtured by, using our and adding to our Research Centers












































THE TIMELINE




- Sept '23 Needs, inspiration and new funds lead to a dream

BIGGEST CHALLENGES SO FAR




WHAT CAN BE IMPROVED SO FAR

- Making choices and Financial plan: dreams need to become real writing for funds



HOW DOES IT LOOK?


 Interdisciplinary groups of students explore with a EhB researcher a challenge that needs to be tangled




ABOUT WHAT REALLY?
